 - 3 of these are upper division PSYC electives from the concentration of your choice
 - 4 of these are upper division PSYC electives
- PSYC 195 (Instructional Assistance) can be credited once towards an UD PSYC elective.
- A 2.0 major GPA is required for gradation. (Major GPA is made up of the 12 UD courses)

*Research lab requirement can be satisfied with either two PSYC Lab courses, two PSYC 199 + APA paper, or one of each.

LD = lower division courses

UD = upper division courses (need at least 90 units to enroll)

PSYC Core = upper division introductory psychology course

PSYC Elective = upper division areas of concentration/specific topics
